- ❖ Successful Xmas decoration competition for Anlaby Primary School
- ❖ Remembrance Day Wreath and attendance at St. Peter's Church Service

- ❖ Consulted on further extension to the car park on Hull Road, Anlaby
- ❖ Held on-site meeting with Officers from the East Riding of Yorkshire Council to discuss new development at 17 Hull Road, Anlaby
- ❖ Still pressing Derwent Estates for the provision of a permanent footpath where the desire line currently exists at Anlaby Retail Park
- ❖ Attendance at Society of Local Council Clerks training days
- ❖ Removal of under-used recycling bins in Hull Road car park to free up much needed parking spaces

- ❖ Successfully co-opted one new Councillor
- ❖ Investigated possibility of installing Controlled Parking Zones (CPZ's) on Pryme Street

- ❖ Further improvements to Anlaby House Grounds, including the installation of three owl boxes, bulb and flower planting and more
