Meet the team-

Your Neighbourhood Policing Team (NPT) plays a vital role in tackling many of the local issues that matter to you. They are out in your area every day, and always available to offer crime prevention advice or for you to raise concerns with.

Each NPT consists of a dedicated Sergeant, Police Constable (PCs) and Police Community Support Officers (PCSOs) all under the command of an inspector. While they may be the ones you see the most, the NPTs do not work alone. They are supported by staff and officers from across the whole Humberside Police force area, and they work closely with local authorities, community leaders and residents to decide the local policing priorities for the area and find useful, long-term solutions.

Our approach is shaped by four key themes: We protect vulnerable people and keep people safe; We are out in your communities, visible, listening and working with you to deliver the services you need; We successfully tackle crime and ASB; We will be there when you need us.

Crimes of note

Residential Burglary reports

11/4/25 Spring Gardens, attempt entry to property after unknown person approaches property and causes damage to the door and lock. Suspects unknown and incident closed pending any further developments.

15/4/25 Sherwood Drive, residential burglary to garage stealing a Carrera bicycle from within.

Business burglary reports

Thefts

2/4/25 Anlaby Retail Park, victim leaves their belongings in a locker while at the gym and not lock the locker, upon returning all belongings had been stolen including wallet and contents. Enquiries ongoing.

5/4/25 Morrisons, shop theft, suspect named and enquiries ongoing.

15/4/25 Aldi, Great Gutter Lane, shop theft, suspects unknown

21/4/25 Sainsburys, shop theft, suspect named and enquiries ongoing.

26/4/25 Well Lane, theft of motor vehicle – suspect named and enquiries ongoing.

Damage

8/4/25 Kenwardly Road, domestic related criminal damaged after known suspect smashes rear door and is arrested and later released while enquiries continue.

29/4/25 Tranby School, two youths riding a motorbike within school grounds and caused damage to the grass. No known suspects currently and enquiries ongoing.

Drugs

22/4/25 St Marks Court, three adult males are detained and searched under section 23 resulting in the arrest for possession of drugs, cannabis and white powder. Investigation still ongoing.



Community Priorities May 2025

• Reduce Theft

We are aware of concerns regarding Thefts in the Ward areas, and we have been working hard to prevent further offences. Throughout May we will be completing regular patrols in the areas of concern.

Reduce ASB – Anti-Social behaviour

Our Policing Teams works with our key partners and the community to reduce anti-social behaviour and the anti-social use of motor vehicles. We provide proactive responses to reports of anti-social behaviour in our neighbourhood Area and are constantly reviewing our patrol strategy to address this. We are working hard with partners to address this and ensure our market towns and rural communities are a safe place to live and work.

You will see a clear police presence on patrol in and around your neighbourhood over the coming months with the intention to engage with youths and obtain intelligence and deal with appropriately.
